Going to college...

We are getting ready for a new academic year. Our children are ready for school and college. Some may be moving to apartments and hostels. They move away from their parents, siblings, and the church and enter a new world. The world of parents, siblings, Sunday School, and the church had some ethos and values. Some of them have been inculcated in our kids. Their worldview, perceptions, attitude, knowledge, and the like have been molded in a framework of Christian and Mar Thoma faith and ethos. Of course, they had other exposures too. But mostly their worldview is dominated by the ethos and values of the parents and the church.

Now, they are entering a new world, a world of freedom, individual choices, liberal politics, political correctness, and the like. They will come across cultural shock situations where their faith, ethos, morals, and practices will be challenged and looked upon as outdated, irrelevant, corrupt, derogatory, discriminatory, and against political correctness. Everything that they believed and valued may be challenged. This will cause a severe crisis in the life of our kids, who are struggling to adjust to the new situation and adapt to the pressure of studies.

There will be other temptations of using liquor, and drugs and engaging in sex. If not yielding to these matters, you may be treated as an outcast. The parents and the children need to be prepared to face this reality.

The situation may be confusing. There will be two ways of responding to it. Some may be upset and perplexed. Some may totally surrender to the new teachings and will become part of it. At this juncture, I would like to remind the following things:

- 1. When you face trouble, confusion, and doubt, openly say that you have a problem, and you need help. There is no vulnerability in confessing your need for help. The church is with you to help you always. Your Sunday school teachers, elder brothers and sisters, and the vicars are there for you to listen to you, guide you and answer your questions. Kindly reach out. Never hesitate to voice your problem, your question, or your doubt and seek help. There is a forgiving God. Your church is a church that can stand with you in every situation.
- 2. Be connected to the parents. Talk to the parents regularly and be open to them. Parents need to be patient and give a listening ear to them. Instead of imposing anything, be kind and compassionate to the kids and to their situations. Never use the words of condemnation but have the courage to correct them. Parents need to create a good relationship and an openness to the kids and to their problems. When you are also troubled, never hesitate to take help. When children find it difficult to communicate with their parents, they must reach out for help to mend their relationship with their parents. A strong relationship with your immediate and extended family is a strength in your life.

- 3. Be strong in your faith. Have confidence in your faith and practices that you have learned in the Mar Thoma Church. Mar Thoma Church presents a Bible-based, balanced faith, which does not go to the extremes of Eastern or Western traditions. Too much Westernization or too much traditionalism is equally unbiblical. Be open to learning our own faith that is proposed by the Mar Thoma Church.
- 4. Hold on to the Biblical worldview. You may come to know about new thoughts, ways of life, beliefs, and attitudes. They are extremely liberal approaches to life and faith. The liberal approach to life challenges every other form of life and it is intolerant of faith, spiritual practices, and modest ways of life. They will confront and attack, insult and put down religious life and modesty as traditional, conservative, and vulnerable. Never be afraid of these thoughts. Never be ashamed of your faith, practices, and modesty. You are well in advance in culture and civilization. Have confidence and faith in yourself, in your parents, in your church, and in your faith.
- 5. Deepen your faith and knowledge in the scripture. Each time you are challenged, your faith and modesty being challenged, turn to the scripture and faith. Learn it more and deep. The church will help you to learn and understand your faith, church, tradition, and your cultural heritage and practices.

STORY TIME



The Holy Bible is filled with amazing stories of Faith and Hope. Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see. There is an undeniably miraculous movement of God in response to the act of Faith.

One such amazing story of Faith is the "Story of Jesus Forgives and Heals a Paralyzed Man [Mark 2:1-12]

Jesus was going from town to town performing miracles and everyone wanted to see Him. People were excited whenever they heard that
Jesus was in their area because they either wanted to see a miracle or
be the one who was healed. So, as Jesus entered one of the homes
in Capernaum, people quickly gathered around Him. So many people
came and that there was no room left, not even outside the door. There
were people gathered outside to see or hear Jesus when He came out.
That's where things got interesting. There were four men who heard
that Jesus was in town who decided to carry their paralyzed friend on a
mat to Him, to see if their friend could be healed. As soon as they got
to the house where Jesus was, they realized that they wouldn't be able
to get through to see Him.

They didn't know how long Jesus would be in town and were desperate to see Him! They made an opening in the roof above Jesus by digging through it and then lowered the mat the man was lying on. These men were so sure that Jesus would be able to heal him; otherwise they wouldn't have gone through so much trouble. The first thing Jesus said when He saw their faith was, "Son, your sins are forgiven."

STORY TIME (Cont'd)

Some of the teacher's of the law heard Jesus forgive the man and they began thinking, "How dare this man forgive sins, only God can do that." Immediately Jesus knew what they were thinking and said to them, "Why are you thinking these things?" This probably startled the men because Jesus knew what they were thinking!

Jesus also asked them, "Which was easier: to say to the paralytic, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Get up, take your mat and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins." This might be a bit hard to understand but Jesus was only trying to get through to the teachers of the law and tell them that He was the Son of Man, and God has given Him the power to forgive sins and heal people. These things could not be done by just a regular person but only by God.

Then before He was finished Jesus said to the paralyzed man, "I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home." The Bible says that the man got up, took his mat and walked out in full view of them all. The crowd was very amazed and they praised God saying, "We have never seen anything like this!"

Faith can move mountains. The Promises of our God always hold true for those who believe with all their heart.

OUR HISTORY

Immanuel Mar Thoma Church is part of the North American Diocese of the Malankara Mar Thoma Syrian Church (Malankara Mar Thoma Suriyani Sabha as it is called in native language Malayalam) which is one of the oldest groups of practicing Christians in the world.

The origins of the Malankara Mar Thoma Syrian Church date back to AD. 52. The Apostle, St. Thomas, one of Jesus's 12 disciples, arrived in Cranganore, on the coast of Malabar in southern India. He spread the Gospel among the Hindu and Jewish settlers. He established seven churches: Malankara, Palur, Parur, Gokamangalam, Niranam, Chayal, and Kalyan. The first century Christians were called Nazarenes, or Mar Thoma (Saint Thomas) Christians. A few families among them where chosen to be responsible for the administration of the Christian community. St. Thomas continued his mission and reached the east coast of India (Kerala), where he later martyred at a place now called St. Thomas Mount. Over centuries, the church has continued to grow and reform, migrating to other parts of India. The traditional form of worship and time-honored ritualistic practices were maintained. Mission work and evangelism were given high importance. In later half of the 20th century, congregations and parishes began forming outside of Kerala to other parts of the world. The Mar Thoma Church developed church organizations, schools, colleges, theological institutions, hospitals, homes for the destitute, old age homes, social welfare establishments, vanita (ladies) hostels, technical institutions, study centers, camp centers, publications, ashrams and mission fields, throughout Kerala and the world.

The Mar Thoma Church is an active member and provides leadership to the World Christian Council and the Council of Christian Churches in India. At present the Mar Thoma Church has over 1000 parishes, with its headquarters in SCS Campus, Tiruvalla, Kerala, India. In the late sixties and early seventies, Mar Thoma families immigrated to North America and Europe for higher education and employment opportunities. The small communities gathered as prayer groups to maintain and foster their spiritual identity. In 1972, the first regular Mar Thoma service began in New York. This laid the foundation for the formation of a number of parishes and later the establishment of The Diocese of North America and Europe in 1988. https://immanuelmtc.org/church-history/


